The two-hour training will dive into the fundamentals of economic development and guide participants on how they can play a pivotal role in fostering growth and collaboration. Topics will include positioning oneself as a key player in economic development, why confidentiality is vital and how strong infrastructure underpins local industry success, how effective incentives can secure deals, and more.

"The National League of Cities just conducted a survey of elected officials nationwide and economic development was the number one topic they said they wanted to learn more about," said Chancellor. "It's important for elected officials and community leaders to learn how investing in economic development provides a long-term return on investment and creates opportunities for their citizens."
