The \$12 million expansion will create 25 new jobs.

The new addition, located at 100 Valley Drive, will encompass 97,000 square feet, including 40,000 square feet of additional manufacturing space, 45,000 square feet of warehouse space and 12,000 square feet of office space.

In addition to the physical expansion, this growth will bring at least 25 new jobs to the area — spanning manufacturing, engineering, and other supporting roles — providing valuable opportunities for the local workforce and contributing greatly to the community’s economic growth.
