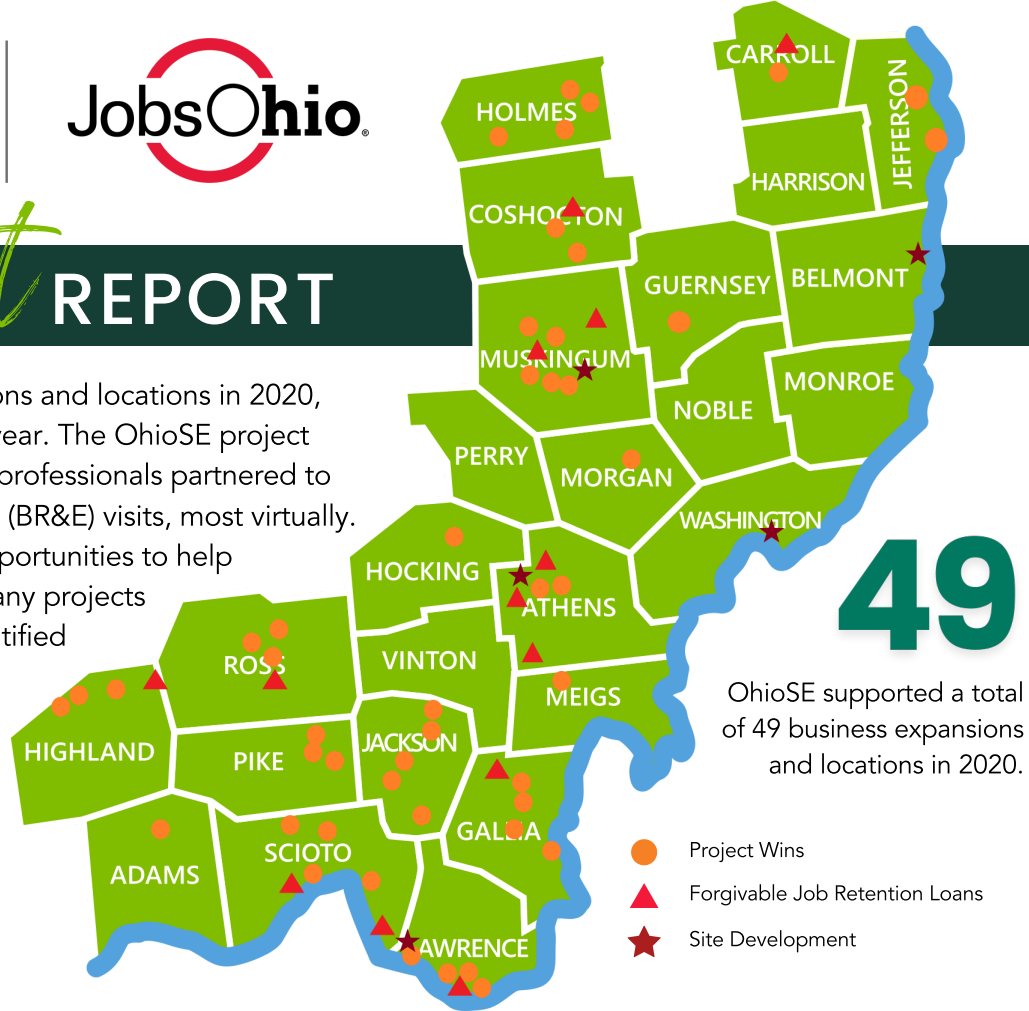
2020 *Impact* REPORT

OhioSE supported 49 business expansions and locations in 2020, double our previous best performance year. The OhioSE project team and local economic development professionals partnered to increase business retention & expansion (BR&E) visits, most virtually. The BR&E visits are critical to finding opportunities to help companies grow. One-third of all company projects supported by OhioSE in 2020 were identified through these BR&E visits.

Together, we completed a record 276 company meetings in 2020, mostly virtually.

To support these 49 projects, OhioSE helped secure \$6.8 million of support from JobsOhio and \$890,728 from the State of Ohio in assistance programs. When we add in COVID-19 response programs and speculative site and building development programs, we brought over \$30 million to the region last year.
